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Joint Statement

New England Commission of Higher Education and New York College of Health Professions

At its meeting on April 23, 2026, the New England Commission of Higher Education (NECHE) issued New York College of Health Professions a Notation because the Commission found that the College is in danger of not meeting the Commission's Standard on *Institutional Resources* due to the financial impact associated with its loss of Title IV eligibility that led to a "notice of uncertainty" in the institution's FY2024 audited financial statements. NYCHP anticipates that the earliest reinstatement of Title IV funding could take effect is Fall 2026. The Commission will monitor the institution's progress through Fall 2026 and Fall 2027 reports to track the institution's success in having its eligibility for federal financial aid reinstated as well as its ability to achieve sufficient enrollment to maintain financial viability.

New York College of Health Professions' President A Li Song said in response: The College has implemented strategic initiatives to stabilize enrollment, strengthen institutional planning, and support the institution's long-term sustainability. At the same time, recognizing the importance of federal financial aid in expanding access and supporting future enrollment growth, NYCHP continues to diligently work with the U.S. Department of Education to restore its Title IV federal Student Aid certification. The College remains focused on maintaining the quality of its academic programs, supporting student success, and advancing its mission of preparing health professionals through rigorous academic and clinical training.

The New England Commission of Higher Education (NECHE) is recognized by the U.S. Department of Education as a reliable authority as to the quality of education. The Commission accredits over 200 degree-granting institutions in the United States, one system with seven universities, and fourteen American-style institutions in other countries. New York College of Health Professions is a private College in Syosset, NY dedicated to offering quality degree programs in holistic health that was first accredited by the Commission in September 2023.
